- Remember you are there to serve the children, this is not the place to hang with your friends.
- Don't yell or scream at the children (Proverbs 15:1)

- Is to assist the teacher
- Get supplies as needed.
- Pass out papers.
- Help with any craft
- Play with the children

Discipline in the classroom:

- All discipline should be handled by the Lead teacher.
- You are not to discipline any child.
- Only the Lead teacher should talk to the parent of any child that has had difficulties in the classroom.
